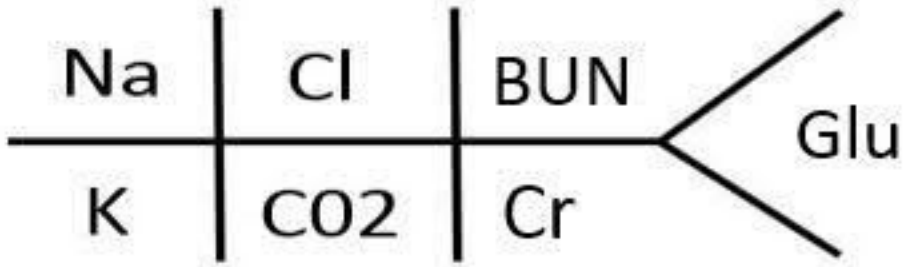


## Morning Rounds: Cases and Therapeutics



### NORMAL LAB VALUES\*

Sodium	135-145 mEq/L
Potassium	3.5-5.0 mEq/L
Chloride	96-106 mEq/L
Carbon Dioxide	20-29 mEq/L
BUN (blood urea nitrogen)	7-18 mg/dL
Creatinine	0.6-1.2 mg/dL
Glucose	70-100 mg/dL
CD4 Cell Count	500-1200 cells/mm <sup>3</sup>
Hemoglobin (Hb)	12.1-15.1 g/dL (female) 13.8-17.2 g/dL (male)

\*Target lab values vary by patient

## SOAP NOTE ACRONYMS

CC	Chief Complaint
HPI	History of Present Illness
PMH	Past Medical History
PSH	Past Surgical History
FH	Family History
SH	Social History
ROS	Review of systems; reviews pertinent body systems directly related to problems listed in HPI
NKDA	No known drug allergies
N/V/D	Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea
PE	Physical examination
HEENT	Head, eyes, ears, nose, throat

**CASE-SPECIFIC TERMS**

Leiomyosarcoma	Cancer of the smooth muscle
Dyspnea	Difficult/labored breathing
Dysuria	Pain or discomfort upon urination
f/c	Fever/chills
Portacath	Device to draw blood and give treatments
s/p	After
Biopsy	Examination of tissue removed from a living body
Dz	Disease
CTAB	Clear to auscultation bilaterally (lung)
Myalgia	Muscle pain
Lymphadenopathy (LAD)	Swollen lymph nodes
Polydipsia	Excessive thirst
Pruritus	Itching
Orthopnea	Shortness of breath while lying flat (sleeping)
Ecchymosis	Discoloration of skin from bleeding underneath (bruising)
Hematuria	Presence of blood in urine
PT	Prothrombin time
PTT	Partial thromboplastin time
AAO	awake, alert & oriented
NTND	Non-tender, non-distended
HSM	Hepatosplenomegaly

Erythema	skin redness
NAD	Nothing abnormal detected (no appreciable disease)
DOE	Dyspnea on exertion
Polyuria	Excessive excretion
Melena	Dark stool
Hematochezia	Bloody stool
Edema	Swelling caused by excessive fluid in body tissue
Dysphagia	Difficulting swallowing

**CASE-SPECIFIC MEDICATIONS**

<b>Medication</b>	<b>Drug Class</b>	<b>Indication</b>
Gemcitabine	Chemotherapy	Cancer of the bladder, breast, ovarian and non-small cell lung
Docetaxel	Chemotherapy	Cancer of the breast, lung, prostate, stomach, head & neck
Ifosfamide	Chemotherapy	Testicular cancer
Hydrocortisone	Corticosteroids	Anti-itch
Lidocaine	Anesthetic	Relieve pain and numb
Morphine	Narcotic	Moderate to severe pain
Ultram (Tramadol)	Narcotic	Moderate to severe pain
Taxotere	Chemotherapy	Cancer of the breast, lung, prostate, stomach, head & neck
Benadryl (Diphenhydramine)	Antihistamine	Pain, itchy, allergies, insomnia,
Olaratumab	Chemotherapy	Soft tissue sarcoma
Doxorubicin	Chemotherapy	Multiple types of cancer
Trabectedin	Chemotherapy	Advanced soft tissue sarcoma
Norco (APAP/Hydrocodone)	Narcotic	Pain
Zofran (Ondansetron)	Antiemetic	Prevention of nausea & vomiting
Lovenox (Enoxaparin)	Anticoagulant	Treat/prevent deep vein thrombosis & pulmonary embolism
